Responding To An Emergency

Following the earthquake in Haiti last week the Trustees have decided to have an offering for the relief work. Haiti is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere with 80% of the population living under the poverty line and 54% in abject poverty. This offering will be sent to Tearfund who are already working with partners in the area. Please place your gifts in the offering plates **TODAY** clearly marked 'Haiti'.



Today's prayers have been written by Cathy who is a Compassion Advocate.
Please pray for

- The 15,000 children sponsored by Compassion in Haiti have been directly impacted by the earthquake and about 50 of Compassion's church partners who run the projects have been seriously hit. Please pray that it will be possible to get these projects up and running again so Compassion can provide urgent care and support to the children and families in their communities. Pray that accurate information will be obtained about specific children who have been injured or killed in the earthquake.
- The family of a Compassion member of staff in Haiti who has died as a result of injuries sustained from the earthquake.
- Strength, endurance, wisdom and unity as Compassion staff in the Haiti office work from the car park (their building has been damaged) and try to meet the overwhelming needs of so many.
- Sponsors who are anxiously awaiting news of whether their sponsored child in Haiti has been affected by the earthquake
- The medical team sent out by Compassion to meet the urgent needs of the people of Haiti, that they may be effective in relieving the suffering of many. The team includes sponsors, donors and staff members.
- The worldwide Church to rise up and minister to its hurting members in Haiti.

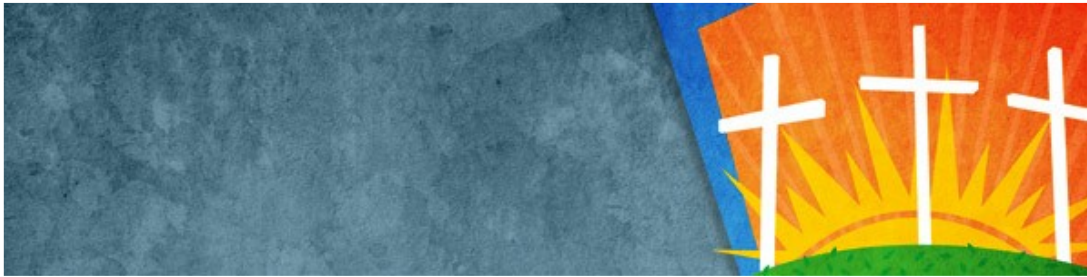
BIG CHURCH

On Sunday 14 February we will be having the first of this year's Big Church services. Having carried out a review last year we still felt that having times when the whole church came together to meet with God was important in the life of the Broadmead Church family.

We will be trying fresh ways to enable all to meet with God, learn more about Him and what it means to follow Him. We are looking for people of all ages to help in the following ways;

- Up front – using communicative skills; for example being willing to be a guest storyteller, part of a drama sketch or work a puppet.
- Preparing creative materials/activities – sourcing video clips etc.

We are also aware that whilst wanting to include as many ages as possible, the very young amongst us (i.e. creche aged children) do not cope well with large group's services – neither do their parents! We would therefore like to offer a creche on Big Church weeks; however the team are already very stretched. If you would be willing to help in the creche even if just on Big Church weeks, that would be incredibly helpful. You would need to be CRB checked which can be easily done.



Good Friday Reflection

Calling all those with creative gifts!

We are looking to open up the sanctuary during the day on Good Friday as a space for people, both from Broadmead and hopefully the wider community, to come, reflect and pray. We would like to set up some worship/reflective stations around the sanctuary and are looking for:

- Poems or written reflections
- Art work – paintings/drawings/sculptures/banners etc.
- Ideas for interactive prayer/worship stations
- Videos/images which could be projected
- Drama/mime
- Music/songs (we may alternate silent/not hours)
- People who have a good eye and can help with the overall setting up of the room

The pieces should all help people to focus on the Easter story, the Father's heart, Jesus, the cost of the Cross, forgiveness and new birth, adoration and worship.

We will also need people to volunteer to be at the church for periods of time for security purposes. Information about exact times will be available shortly.
