Terms of Reference:

- To be facilitators of fundraising for the building development fund within the church
- To develop a fund raising strategy for the building development fund
- To encourage appropriate fundraising events and activities within the church
- To investigate appropriate sources of external funding To regularly inform the church of progress
- To celebrate with the church the points of achievement
- To develop clear ways for church members and regular attenders to give to the fund
- **To ensure that at least 10% of the funds raised are used for the benefit of other Christian organisations and workers**

Strategy:

Funding from a variety of sources:

- Internal: members giving in a variety of ways
 - Regular giving
 - One off events
 - Money boxes and smartie tubes
- External: possibility of grants and loans but potential funders will want to see that we are committed before writing out their cheques!

Caution 1 - the Fundraising team will not:

- Organise all the events
- Raise all the money

Caution 2:

- This needs to be in addition to our normal giving!






